

Alcohol, Drug Abuse, and Violence Prevention Committee (Summary of Activities)

- EGSC has been awarded a **grant from the Georgia Department of Highway Safety**. Through money received through this grant, EGSC will be able to increase alcohol and other drug programming on campus.
- **October 2015**-EGSC employees completed an on-line module which provided information on EGSC faculty/staff Alcohol and Drug policy as well as information about the health risks and consequences of Alcohol and other drug use.
- **October 21, 2015**- EGSC Student Life hosted **Red Ribbon Week**. Giveaways were provided and students signed a pledge to remain drug-free.
- **November 3, 2015**- Student Life and EGSC Athletics hosted **“Enduring Regret”, a presentation featuring Chris Sandy and Eric Krug** on the dangers of drinking and driving.
- **November 2015**- Students are currently completing **EverFi training (Alcohol Edu for College)** which is an on-line, interactive course/program designed to reduce the negative consequences of alcohol amongst students. The online program delivers a personalized experience to all types of students dependent on their current drinking choices. Students are also required to complete the **EverFi Haven course/program** which addresses issues of sexual assault, relationship violence, and stalking amongst students, faculty, and staff.
- **November 2015**- Faculty and staff are currently in the process of completing **EverFi training**. This is an on-line, interactive course/program which addresses issues of sexual assault, relationship violence, and stalking among students, faculty, and staff.
